

Q HOW IS A MOLESAFE SKIN SCREENING DIFFERENT THAN A TRADITIONAL SKIN CHECK?



A Most dermatologists perform only a brief visual skin check to look for melanoma. These checks do not allow the doctor to identify any changes as they have no way to compare the patient's lesions from one visit to the next. MoleSafe is a tool used by dermatologists to benefit their patients. At MoleSafe, we spend an average of one hour on each visit, first doing total body photography and then using a dermatoscope to check, image, and molemap most pigmented lesions on a patient's body. This provides a powerful tool for subsequent evaluation and management of your skin. In addition, these images are reviewed by an expert dermoscopist who interprets these images and renders a report for both the patient and their physician.

Patients at risk for melanoma are followed annually. New lesions are imaged and existing lesions are re-imaged and the images are compared to search for subtle signs of change that may indicate melanoma. The fact is that early detection is the only cure for melanoma, and the MoleSafe system produces remarkable results.
